

## Lake Zurich LPOA Fishing Recommendations

The Lake Zurich LPOA wants to provide the best possible fishing opportunities to owners and the community. Below are recommendations that we have made based on creel surveys, ILDNR Biologist, Keystone Hatchery Biologist and of course feedback from fisherman.

- Largemouth Bass: Keep 12" - 14" 3 per day however only consume 1 per month according to the Illinois Public Health Department. Please see the following web site <https://itgov.illinois.gov/news/press-release.29872.html>
- Walleye: Keep 14"- 18" 3 per day. All other sizes should be released back to the lake.
- Northern Pike: State minimum to keep is 24", 3 per day
- Muskie: Release all back to the lake CPR - CATCH PHOTO RELEASE
- Panfish: Any combination of 10 with species below can be kept
- Bluegill, Sunfish and Perch – 6-8"
- Crappie 10" minimum to ensure good spawning populations

**Carp: Remove from lake at any opportunity**
